RE: Energy Conservation and the new Police facility

With this memo, the Melbourne Beautification and Energy Efficiency Board (BEEB) respectfully requests the City of Melbourne make energy conservation of highest priority during the design and construction of the newly approved Police facility.

The BEEB had requested Mr. Rory Dittmer (Design Supervisor) discuss consideration of same during our March meeting. Mr. Dittmer indicated that while he was supportive of our request, making a public presentation during contract negotiations would be counterproductive.

The BEEB thinks the construction of the new Police facility presents enormous opportunity for the City to demonstrate (and benefit from) its commitment to “develop and implement an environmental sustainability plan for city operations with a goal of achieving 100% clean energy by 2035”.
